

Message for Potential Program Applicants and Our Partners

As we approach the end of our fiscal operating year and to facilitate the transition to a new provider of our adult career and training services, it will be necessary to place a temporary halt on new enrollments for Virginia Career Works adult and dislocated worker **starting the week of May 18th, 2026 and lasting through June 30, 2026.**

This does not apply to Career Advantage services for 17–24 year old out-of-school youth.
